SUBJECT: DTC Custodians participating in the Deposit/Withdrawal at Custodian (DWAC) System

Under the DWAC system, a Participant can transmit, via the PDWC function on the Participant Terminal System (PTS), a request to a FAST transfer agent or other DTC Custodian (a "DTC Custodian") to deposit securities in the Participant's DTC account. Similarly, a Participant can request a DTC custodian to withdraw and dispose of securities in the Participant's DTC account.

The following DTC Custodian has agreed to participate in the DWAC system. Participants wishing to use the system should contact the custodian to determine what its requirements are with respect to deposits and withdrawals.
